We will be...

- talking about healthy food and exercise

At Home:

- practice putting on and taking off shoes and socks

Literacy

We will be...

- writing our names using the correct letter formation
- hear the initial sounds in words
- linking letters to sounds
- oral blending of CVC words
- Attempt writing for different purposes: ie -letters, invitations, messages labels, stories

At Home:

Mathematics

We will be....

- counting forwards and backwards to 10 and finding these numbers in and out of sequence
- matching the quantity to the correct number
- looking at the correct formation of numbers when writing
- going on a shape hunt around the school looking for 3 dimensional shapes

- point out numbers in the environment
